
INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Shower Drain with or without Flange Kit




1. Cut a chamfered hole at the location where the drain will be located, the maximum diameter at the upper part of the hole should be 6-1/2", this will allow the flange to sit flush with the sub-floor.




3. Connect the flange to the drainpipe; drive wood screws into the 4 holes on the flange edge, the top of the flange should be flush with the subfloor.




5. Using a utility knife cut an x at the location where the 4 bolts will be threaded and in the center of the drain, carefully cut off the excess pieces of liner from the center of the drain by running your knife along the inside diameter of the drain flange, re-thread all 4 bolts into the flange.



2. Evenly apply adhesive to the inside area where the flange will be connected to the drain.





4. Prep the floor for a waterproof membrane using the appropriate methods and materials, apply adhesive to the grooved part of the flange and install membrane as per manufacturer's instructions.




6. Insert and turn the clamping ring on the flange and tighten the bolts.







7. Connect the adapter and install on the flange (Hexagonal thread adapter and rubber adapter are optional).




Test that all connections are watertight by pouring some water and checking for leaks.



8. Apply adhesive to the outer surface of the drain housing connector and insert into the shower drain adapter, although the drain should be set at 1/6" below the finish floor level, you can do a final adjustment prior to installing the final flooring surface by inserting or pulling the adapter, make sure to level the drain housing.



10. Cover the drain opening to prevent any debris from going into the drain.





11. Pour the mortar and install the final flooring surface, make sure to slope the mortar at a 2% grade or 1/4" /ft.



Before Installation:


• Please allow a 4" x 4" space on the tile for drain flange.


Installation:

- 1. Slowly press the floor drain on to a threaded adaptor or a rubber adaptor.
- 2. If using a threaded adaptor, make sure the shank on the bottom of floor drain is fully pushed in. Turning the threaded adaptor to adjust the installation height of the floor drain.



3. If using a rubber adaptor, make sure the rubber adaptor is fully pushed in the flange base. Gently pull up or press down the floor drain to adjust the installation height of the floor drain.





Care and Maintenance:

- Clean periodically of any debris that has accumulated.
- To clean, remove cover and dome grid, remove any debris present and re-insert all component.
