




#### TOOLS REQUIRED





#### Before you begin your installation:

- For your own safety, this grab bar should be installed by a licensed professional.
- A grab bar is as good as the way it's installed.
- Make sure to confirm that there is proper wood backing at both points of attachment for this grab bar.
- If there is no wood backing no wood backing available at both point, attach a 2"
   x 6" minimum piece of lumber between the studs.
- Maximum weight capacity is 292 LBS (132 KGS).

#### **Installation Steps:**

- 1. Place bar at the desired location. Level and mark the location of the holes.
- 2. Remove bar and pre-drive all the screws in at the marked location with electric screwdriver, then remove all the screws from the wall.
- 3. Place the grab bar back and align the flange base with the screw holes.
- 4. Due to the tight space, use electric screw driver to drive all the screws only about 1/2 depth, then one by one tighten up all screws to secure the grab bar.
- 5. Press flanges to the base and turn clockwise to lock in place.

#### Cleaning

Clean with a damp cloth only.

Avoid using metal or abrasive polishes.
