

# Grab Bar Shelf Installation



#### Parts:

## Mounting Screw



## Before you begin your installation:


- 1. A grab bar is as good as the way it's installed.
- 2. Make sure to confirm that there is proper wood backing at both points of attachment for this grab bar.
- 3. If there is no wood backing available at both points, attach a 2" x 6" minimum piece of lumber between the studs.
- 4. If a proper wood bracing is not available, consult your contractor as to the best anchors to use for your specific application some options available are Tile/ masonry anchors, toggle bolts, plastic anchors, metal anchors and drywall anchors
- 5. Maximum weight capacity is 300 LBS.



## **Installation Steps:**

- Step 1. Place bar at the desired location. Level and mark the location of the holes.
- Step 2. Remove bar and drill starter holes (5/64").
- Step 3. Mount grab bar to the wall using 2" screws, or the appropriate anchors for your specific wall type.
- Step 4. Press flanges to the base and turn clockwise to lock in place.

#### Cleaning

Clean with a damp cloth only. Avoid using metal or abrasive polishes.
