




Note: The sprayer fits only hose adapters with a 1/2 NPSM inner thread (1/2 IPS straight female thread).

Installation Steps:

- Remove the old sprayer head from the spray hose adapter by turning it counter-clockwise. Clean any debris from the adapter and flush the hose with water. Check for a rubber washer; if it's broken or deformed, replace it and ensure it sits properly in the adapter.
- 2. Install the new sprayer head by threading it clockwise onto the adapter. Tighten it by hand, but do not over-tighten, as this can cause damage and leaks.
- 3. Turn on the water for at least 1 minute to check for leaks. If any leaks are found, loosen the sprayer head, clean out debris, and reassemble the O-ring and rubber washer before re-tightening.
- 4. Turn on the water and press the flow-pattern button on the sprayer head to ensure the flow pattern.
