
Mark a horizontal level line at the height where the top of the backsplash will be situated, measure 3/8" down from the previous line and mark another horizontal

leveled line.




Place the top of the hanger at the lower line and mark the location of the holes, remove the wall hanger and drill 1/2" holes at the marked locations.

Remove the nut and washers from the anchors, insert anchor on wall hanger, insert washers and thread nut, install wall hanger by pressing plate against the wall making sure that all anchors are inserted in the pre-drilled holes, tighten all nuts with a socket or adjustable wrench.




Pre-install the faucet, supply lines and drain on the sink, apply caulking around the perimeter of the lip and back of the sink and gently set it down on the counter. Clean excess caulking, Install trap as per manufacturer's instructions

Before Installation


- Follow all local building codes.
- Open box and make sure that all the components are complete.
- Because of the weight of this sink it is recommended that you recruit the assistance of a second person.



For wall mount installation

It is recommended that this sink be secured to 2" x 6" lumber bracing on the wall where it is to be installed.

Measure the desired height of the sink and mark a horizontal leveled line at the height where the top of the backsplash will be situated, measure 3/8" down from the previous line and mark another horizontal leveled line.





Place the top of the hanger at the lower line and mark the location of the holes, remove the wall hanger and drill 1/2" holes at the marked locations.

Remove the nut and washers from the anchors, insert anchor on wall hanger, insert washers and thread nut, install wall hanger by pressing plate against the wall making sure that all anchors are inserted in the pre-drilled holes, tighten all nuts with a socket or adjustable wrench.




Pre-install the faucet, supply lines and drain on the sink, apply a bead of adhesive caulking to the back of the sink and install on the wall hanger, Install P-trap as per manufacturer's instructions and check for leaks around the drain.

For drop-in Installation

Cut a perimeter hole on the counter top where the sink is to be installed.

Build a support structure below the top of the counter, make sure to secure structure to the floor and side walls of the cabinet, and that it is strong enough to support 100 Lbs. Allow space for the drain connection.




INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Utility Sink Drain

Need Tools:



INSTALLATION:

- Clean area around the sink drain hole and apply a bead of silicone based caulking to the underside of the drain flange and insert into drain hole from the top.
- 2. From below the sink slide rubber washer up onto the drain threads until it comes in contact with the sink.
- Thread locknut by hand, make sure the drain is centered on the sink drain hole and tighten lock nut using a basin wrench, be careful not to overtighten especially if it is being installed on a porcelain or fireclay sink.
- 4. Secure the "P" trap to the drain using the provided compression nut and rubber gasket.
