## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Tub Drain & Round Overflow Trim

## Instructions:


- 1. Remove the Old Drain Stopper: Unthread the stopper by turning counterclockwise.
- Clean the Area: Clean the area around the drain opening and place the new sealing washer (#1) beneath the tub, ensuring the lips are facing upward.
- 4. Prepare for Installation: Insert washer (#2) and apply plumber's putty under the new drain flange.
  Additionally, wrap Teflon tape around the threads.
- 5. Install the New Drain: Carefully thread the drain by hand, then finish tightening with the 4-way wrench or dumbbell wrench. Remove any excess putty around the flange.

- 6. Remove the Old Overflow Cover: Unthread the overflow cover by turning it counterclockwise.
- 7. Loosen the Screw Rod: Using an adjustable wrench, turn the screw rod counterclockwise to loosen it.
- 8. Remove Components: Take out the screw rod, overflow flange, and sealing rubber washers from the back of the tub.
- 9. Install the New Washer: Place the new black rubber washer on the overflow drain elbow, ensuring it makes full and even contact with the sealing surface.
- 10. Attach the Flange: Insert the flange and silicone washer (#4) onto the screw rod. Thread the screw rod onto the elbow and tighten with an adjustable wrench, being careful not to over-tighten.
- 11. Install the Overflow Cover: Thread the overflow cover onto the screw rod by turning it clockwise.
